Entries:

- **Entry Forms Accepted through Saturday, August 6, 2011 BY 5 PM.**
- Post Entries Accepted from Aug. 7-20, 2011 for an additional \$25.00 per contestant.
- Drug Fee: \$5.00 per horse/per day
- **Show Starts Sunday, September 4, 2011 at 8 AM**

Rules & Information:

- Refer to Horse Show General Rules, Page 2, and Local Rules, Page 61
- **Limited to Mariposa County Residents only.** Contestants under 18 shall be enrolled in a Mariposa County school or be signed for by parent or guardian who must be a Mariposa County resident. Contestants over 18 shall reside in the county for at least 90 days prior to the opening day of fair. Fair Management reserves the right to request the necessary verification to establish the required residency.
- Tie breaking will be determined by a rope-off.

LOCAL TEAM ROPING

Entry Fee: \$35 Per Person + Drug Fee

Stock Charge: \$40 per team Purse: \$15 + Drug Fee: \$5 per horse/per day

Class	Description
1	LOCAL TEAM ROPING:

Roper may enter three times with different partners. Everyone gets 3 head. Only teams that catch all three go to 4th round. Legal catches around horns, neck or half a head. Front leg equals no time. Three loops, either end. Catch pen will be open. Steers nose crosses the exit gate line Team is flagged out. Ropes must be tight and ropers faced for flag. Winners to be determined as follows: First place team catching all four head with fastest average going back as needed to those catching three head, etc.

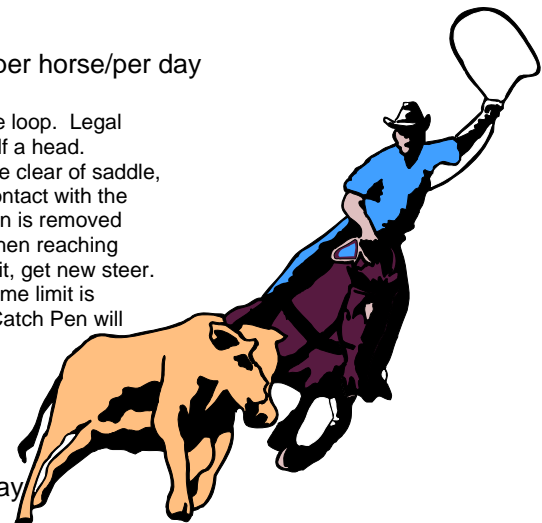
SADDLE ROPING

Entry Fee: \$35 Per Person + Drug Fee

Stock Charge: \$20 Purse: \$15 + Drug Fee: \$5 per horse/per day

Class	Description
2	SADDLE ROPING:

One steer. Roper begins behind barrier. One loop. Legal catches are around horns, around neck or half a head. Mucker may not bull dog steer. Rope must be clear of saddle, horse and tack before contestant comes in contact with the ribbon. Steer must be on its feet before ribbon is removed from tail. Roper must have piece of ribbon when reaching circle. If ribbon falls off before roper touches it, get new steer. Ribbon to be tied on tail just above switch. Time limit is 60-seconds. Mucker must start from circle. Catch Pen will remain closed.



CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS ROPING

Entry Fee: \$35 Per Person + Drug Fee

Stock Charge: \$20 Purse: \$15 + Drug Fee: \$5.00 per horse/per day

Class	Description
3	CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS:

Limited to former Mariposa County Local Saddle Roping winners, 2010 and before. Steer stopping with two-steer average. One loop. Legal catches are around horns, around neck or half a head. To stop time roper must dally and steer must be facing roper. Catch pen will remain open.
