Entries:

- **Entry Forms Accepted through Saturday, August 3, 2019 BY 5 PM.**
- **Post Entries** Accepted from Aug. 4 - 17, 2019 for an additional \$25.00 per Team.
- **Team Penning starts Monday, September 2, 2019 at 1 PM**

Rules & Information:

- Refer to Horse Show General Rules
- Team Penning ~ Limited to residents of Mariposa, Madera, Merced, Fresno, Stanislaus, Calaveras & Tuolumne Counties
- Team Penning ~Time starts when 1st steer breaks the eye and stops when gate is closed.
- Team Penning Participants may go twice, but with different partners.
- Team Penning ~ limited to the first 40 teams with **COMPLETED ENTRIES RECEIVED** in the fair office.

- Jr. Teams will run last (**Jr. age is 7-13 as of 01/01/2019**)
- Jr. Teams ~ 2 cattle, a gate will be between the pen and fence, Jr. Team does not close gate, one or both team members will throw hand(s) in the air when done. There will be a 60 second penalty for only 1 steer penned.

Awards:

- **Must pen at least 1 steer to qualify for awards.**
- Fastest Jr. Team will receive sponsored award.
- No cash awards for Jr. penning
- **NEW: Purse split 3 places for open penning class ~ 50% - 30% - 20%, Points are awarded to 5 placings**
- Rosettes and Sponsored awards

OPEN PENNING

Entry Fee: \$100.00 Per Team

Stock Charge: \$30 per contestant Purse: \$20 per contestant

LOT# Description

- 1 **Open Penning:** Two person team. Both start behind barrier. Maximum two-minute time limit. Event will be progressive once there are five (5) qualified times. Contestants may set gate to their preference. Either rider or both may close gate from ground or horseback. Rider and horse must be outside gate when closed. 20-second penalty for broken barrier. 60-second penalty for each steer not penned.

JR PENNING

Entry Fee: \$60.00 Per Team

Stock Charge: \$30 per contestant

- 2 **JR. Penning:** Two person team. Both start behind barrier. Time limit will be set & announced by arena director. Gate will be open & attached to the fence. Either rider or both may signal flagger when done by throwing hand(s) into the air; Jr. riders do not have to enter the pen or close the gate. 20-second penalty for broken barrier. 60-second penalty for each steer not penned.
