- Cut flowers must have their own foliage, except in arrangements. Spent blooms should be removed.
- Whole exhibits or portions of exhibits may not be entered in more than one class.
- All fresh flowers and foliage must be in water. Watering of potted plants is sole responsibility of exhibitor.
- Any plants showing evidence of parasites or disease will be disqualified by the department head at the time they are brought to the fairgrounds
