- 1. Exhibitors will comply with printed Fair and State rules, and accept responsibility for their exhibits.
- 2. Exhibitors will indemnify the Fair and the State of California from any loss resulting from rules enforcement.
- 3. Exhibitors must be able to prove their own eligibility and that of their exhibits according to fair rules and acknowledge that misrepresentation of any kind is prohibited.
- 4. Junior exhibitors are expected to prepare, manage and present their own exhibits.
- 5. Exhibitors will conduct themselves with sportsmanship, integrity and cooperation with all participants.
- 6. In the case of animals;
- a. exhibitors will exhibit healthy animals and handle them with care; and
- b. exhibit them in their unaltered conformation, except for common animal husbandry practices; and
- . use all pharmaceuticals, biologics and other chemicals lawfully and with notification to fair management as it specifies.
