- Exhibits to fair on Friday, August 16, 2024, between 4-7 PM or Saturday, August 17 2024, between 1 – 5 PM
- Exhibits picked up, Monday September 2, 2024, from 6:30 PM-7:30PM or Tuesday September 3, 2024, 8am-12 NOON

RULES AND INFORMATION:

- Limited to residents of Mariposa County and Eastern Madera County (east of Madera Canal).
- Judging will be closed.
- Exhibits in this division shall have been made or created by exhibitor (except collections) and completed within the last 12 months preceding the fair and must not have been previously exhibited at a Mariposa County Fair.
- Large items requiring more than three square feet of exhibit space will be accepted on a space available basis and have prior approval by fair management no later than August 3, 2024.
- **Picture** is framed with screw eyes and wire, ready to hang. **Wall hanging** is unframed but has a usable hanger
- **DEFINITION OF ENTRY LEVELS:**
 - Novice/Intermediate:** Exhibitors who have been exhibiting in this division for up to 5 years.
 - Advanced/Professional:** Exhibitors who have been exhibiting in this division for 6 or more years and professionals.
