- Judging: Saturday, September 2, 2023, beginning at 9 AM
- Lamb Released: Monday, September 4, 2023, at 6:00 PM

- **NO TUBES AND OR BLANKETS AT SHOW RING. NO EXCEPTIONS**
- **ALL SHEEP MUST HAVE AN OFFICIAL USDA APPROVED SCRAPIE IDENTIFICATION.**
- Breeding animals will be entered and shown in the open classes.
- Sheep must be shown in a Natural State. Exhibitors are allowed to clip their animals.
- No wash racks at the fair.
