RULES AND INFORMATION:

NEW: ALL BEEF MUST BE SLICK SHORN FOR FAIR TO WITHIN 1/4 INCH OF GROWTH.

Entire Beef must be shorn, excluding leg area from knee & hock down, tail head & Poll head.

No clipping will be permitted on fairgrounds. (Exception: animals not meeting above requirements may be touched-up with Livestock Supervisor's Supervision).

- MUST BE 16 TO 24 MONTHS OF AGE ONLY
- Breeding animals will be entered and shown in the open classes.
- No wash racks at the fair.
